COMPLEX REHABILITATION WARD

We are delighted that a purpose built complex rehabilitation ward is nearing completion at Castle Hill Hospital. Due to open later this year, we understand it will include a training kitchen and therapy rooms where patients will be supported to make the best possible recovery.

Prior to discharge, assessment of a patient's abilities to do every day living skills can then be used to shape a fully supported Community Care Plan.

Top tips to protect yourself and others



- Be extra careful if you receive any phone calls, texts or emails from anyone claiming to be a bank or other trusted organisation. A genuine bank or organisation will never contact you out of the blue to ask for your PIN, full password, card reader codes, passcodes, or to move money to another "safe" account. Personal information is yours. Don't give it away. If in doubt, call us directly using the number on the back of your card
- Never click on a link received in an email or text that then takes you to a website requesting personal information or login details. Always go via a search engine or direct to the company website.
- Never allow anyone remote access to your computer. Scammers will often ask you to download an app or will send you an email with a link such as Team Viewer. You will also never receive a genuine call to tell you your wi-fi or internet is slow
- Watch out for poor grammar or spelling on emails/printed material/letters.
- Take 5. Stop and think about what you are being asked to do.

 If concerned, stop and talk to your family or a friend.
